

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



1. Who should come to HowToLife NYC?

All NYC area young people. Christian, or not. This is an evangelistic outreach event! Young people will be challenged to begin a relationship with Jesus. We are especially focusing on reaching young people from the five boroughs of NYC, but anyone in the tri-state area is welcome to attend.

2. Where is the event?

The Centennial Memorial Theater, a.k.a. "Salvation Army Theater", is located on 120 W. 14th St in midtown Manhattan. There are 1,300 seats. We are praying for a full house!

3. When is the event?

Saturday, March 22, 2025, 6 to 9 p.m. Doors open at 5 pm. Please arrive early!

4. What will happen at this event?

HowToLife events are completely led by Christian students, representing many different NYC area churches and schools. Everyone on the stage is a young person, ages 16 – 24. From the very beginning, youth hosts will welcome the students, and make everyone feel very comfortable. Young people will lead in worship music several times throughout the evening. The rest of the program features honest and transparent student testimonies, what we call "hope stories." Young people will share about their journey to faith, and how Jesus has made all the difference. A final speaker will share the Gospel message, and clearly explain what it means to begin a relationship with Jesus Christ. Young people will be given a chance to respond to the Gospel during a prayer time to begin a relationship with Christ. The very end of the evening we invite young people to fill out a response card, to let us know if they prayed to begin a relationship with Christ.

5. Will church leaders be informed about any commitments to Christ?

Yes! If a young person indicates a local church on their commitment form, we will let the church leader know. This is part of our commitment to follow-up strategy.

6. What other aspects to the follow-up should we expect?

Young people will be challenged to get plugged into a local church. Also, much organic follow-up takes place through the students, due to the unique nature of a student-led outreach.

7. What is HowToLife Movement?

HowToLife Movement is the world's largest Gen Z-led missions and evangelism organization. For 10 years, over 180 HowToLife Movement events have taken place all over the United States, and in 12 countries around the world. Tens of thousands of young people have attended these events, with thousands making commitments to Christ. Over the last several years, powerful HowToLife NYC area events have taken place in Brooklyn, Bronx, Newark, NJ, Elizabeth, NJ, Paterson, NJ, and Long Island. This will be the first in Manhattan.

HowToLife Movement is a 501(c)3 ministry organization, with accreditation from the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability since 2018. HTLM is governed by a board of directors, and led by global director, Jordan Whitmer.
